

# Wisconsin Approved Electronic Certificates of Veterinary Inspection (CVIs)

The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) recommends the use of electronic CVIs. Electronic CVIs provide advantages over paper CVIs because:

- They are electronically and automatically submitted to both Wisconsin and the state of destination. There is no need to mail forms.
- They are legible.
- They can save information, making subsequent entry of the same information more efficient.
- They can electronically incorporate official identification data.



Below are electronic CVIs approved for use by Wisconsin veterinarians. The approved list is expected to change as available eCVIs change.
